Morning meet the guide at hotel, have a day tour to **Ancient CityWall, Bell Tower, History Museum, Grand Mosque, Hui Food street**

The Ancient City Wall, which stretches round the old city. The northern side runs parallelto the railway. Xian was originally a walled city, and even todaythe wall is considered a landmark dividing the city into the inner part and theouter part. The city wall is massive - tall, long andthick. The South Gateand North Gate are the two main entrances to the inner city. Thecity itself is neatly arranged along the city wall.

The Shaanxi HistoryMuseum in Xian, regarded as "the pearl of ancient dynasties and house of Chinese treasures", gives a miniature overview of the thousands of years of Chinese history and the splendid ancient cultures of olden times.

The Grand Mosque of Xian is the largest and best preserved of the earlymosques of China. Builtprimarily in the Ming Dynasty when Chinese architectural elements weresynthesized into mosque architecture, the mosque resembles a fifteenth centuryBuddhist temple with its single axis lined with courtyards and pavilions.

Bell Tower is the largest andbest-preserved bell tower of its kind in China. In ancient times itwas used to tell time together with the Drum Tower:the bell-toll meant that morning was coming, and the drumbeat meant that nightwas falling. The tower marks the geographical center of Xi'an'sold city and is within sight of the Drum Tower. Many artexhibitions are held here throughout the year.

Hui Food street -Muslim Quarter is just located behind (north of) the Drum Tower. The Xian Muslim quarter is a delightful place you mustn't miss! The bazaar inthe Muslim area is most attractive with a wide area of stalls sellingeverything. The streets and walkways are full of life. The shopping is great, very cheap and some unusual items we will seldom see anywhere else in China.
