Day 1

Morning fly toXian, meet arrival, visit Big Wild Goose Pagoda, AncientCity Wall.

As the symbol of the old-line Xian, **Big Wild Goose Pagoda** (DayanPagoda) is a well-preserved ancient building and a holy place forBuddhists. It is located in the southern suburb of Xian City, about 4 kilometers (2.49 miles) from the downtown of thecity. Standing in the Da Cien Temple complex, it attracts numerous visitors for its fame in the Buddhist religion, simple but appealing style of construction, and its new square in front of the temple. It is rated as a National Key Cultural Relic Preserve as well as an AAAA TouristAttraction.

The firstlandmark visitors will encounter in Xian is the **Ancient City Wall**, which stretches round the old city. The northern side runs parallelto the railway. Xian was originally a walled city, and even todaythe wall is considered a landmark dividing the city into the inner part and theouter part. The city wall is massive - tall, long andthick. The South Gateand North Gate are the two main entrances to the inner city. Thecity itself is neatly arranged along the city wall.

Day 2

Visit the Terra Cotta Museum, HuaQing Spring Pool.

The **Terra Cotta museum** isnot only a treasure house, but also a main scenic spot of Xiancity. Today the eighth wonder of the world has almost become synonymof the Terra-cotta Warriors and Horses in 1987; the Emperor Qins Mausoleum wasput on the list of the UNESCO as a world-class cultural heritage site. Nowthe museum is widely known as a huge modern site museum and it is going to be one of the best in the world.

Then,visit **Hua Qing Spring Pool**, also called HuaQing Palace,is a famous scenic hot spring spot in China, situated in the north of LiMountain. In the ancient times, emperors' in Zhou, Qin, Han, Sui andTang dynasty used this secluded place for leisure and entertainment. Thewater in the pools is very clean, so the bottom of the basin is still visibledespite the stream just beneath the water surface. Calming sound ofthe murmuring running water makes Hua Qing Palaceeven more enjoyable.

Day 3

Morning fly to Guilin, meet arrival, visit Elephant Trunk Hill, Fubo Hill, ReedFlute Cave.

Elephant Trunk Hill, also called the elephant hill, lies on the conjunction of the LiRiver and the peach blossom river. It is the badge of Guilin city. Thewhole hill looks exactly like a huge elephant stretching its trunk drinkingwater of the Li River. It is the masterpiece of karsts landscape, composed of pure limestone deposited on seabed 360million years ago.

The **FuboHill** is well known as the "Wonderland on Wave" with its exquisite peak rising high and its foot half in water and half onland. The east of the cave curbs the river stream, causing the formation of a deep pool, so the hill is named Fubo Hill (Wave-Curbing Hill).

Reed Flute Cave is a famous scenic spot, located atthe northwest of Guilin City, 5 kilometers away from the centreof the city, mainly offering a magic fairyland of stalactites, stalagmites, stone columns, curtains and flowers in fantastic shapes and colors whileappreciating landscape and rural scenery.

The **LiRiver** is famous for its fine views: verdant mountains, fragrantwaters, mysterious grottoes, and exquisite rocks. Its unusual karststopography hillsides have often been compared to those at Halong Bay, Vietnam. Alongthe 100-kilometer stretch of the River Li, mountain peaks rise into thesky. The Li River brimming with crystal-clear waters twists and turnsbetween magnificent and beautiful mountains. Its banks are coveredwith lush bamboo and luxuriantly green woods. LuohanMountain, ChaobanMountain, WuzhiMountain and Luosi Mountainrise up from under the waters.
