VisitBadalingGreat Wall&Ming Tombs.

In the early morning, we will drive to the **BadalingGreat wall**. The Great Wallsymbolizes Chinese ancient history. It is a UNESCO World Heritage sitebuilt in stages throughout the ages, designed as defense from attacks from thenorth. It is often said that the Great Wall stretches aroundone-twentieth of the worlds circumference, and is the only man-made object visible from space with the naked eye. The section of the Great Wall that is most often visited was built during the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644 A.D.). The sheer scale of the wall can only be appreciated with a visit to marvel at the human endeavorneeded to create such a magnificent structure.

After that, visit**Ming Tombs**(Shi San Ling). Located about50 kilometers northwest of Beijing, the Ming Tombs liesscattered at the southern foot of Tianshou Mountain in Changpingcountry. Within the Ming Tombsare 13 of the 16 emperors of the Ming Dynasty. Two tombs are open to the public for viewing. One is Chang Tomb, the largest of the tombs, and the other is Ding Tomb. You will visit either one.

VisitTiananmen Square, Forbidden City, Summer Palace, late afternoon flyto Xian, check in the hotel.

Directly to the south of The Forbidden City lies **Tiananmen Square**. This famous squarehouses The Great Hall of the People and is the final resting place of ChairmanMao Zedong, of which a huge portrait hangs at the entrance to The ForbiddenCity, keeping watch over Tiananmen Square. It was also in this square that Chairman Mao Zedong made his 1949 speech proclaiming the founding of the Peoples Republic China.

Get early to visit**The Forbidden City**, formally known asthe Palace Museum,is located in the exact centre of Beijing. It is the base aroundwhich all of Beijinghas since evolved. The building was completed in the early15th century, and it served as an imperial palace for the emperors of Ming andQing Dynasties, ruling over china for nearly 500 years. The museum boastsmany ancient artifacts, art pieces and priceless antiques. Popularly known asthe venue for the film "The Last Emperor," this is a must-seecultural highlight during any visit to Beijing.

Then, visit the former summer resort of the famousEmpress Dowager Cixi, the **Summer Palace** and masterpiece of Chinese landscape and garden design. It is built tooverlook Kunming Lake, and features Longevity Hill, which 60 m high and offersviews of the surrounding palaces and gardens.

VisitBig Wild Goose Pagoda, Ancient City Wall, and Shaanxi History Museum.

As the symbol of the old-line Xian, **Big Wild Goose Pagoda**(Dayan Pagoda) is awell-preserved ancient building and a holy place for Buddhists. It is located in thesouthern suburb of Xian City, about 4 kilometers(2.49 miles) from the downtown of the city. Standing in the Da Cien Templecomplex, it attracts numerous visitors for its fame in the Buddhist religion, its simple but appealing style of construction, and its new square in front of the temple. It is rated as a National Key Cultural Relic Preserve aswell as an AAAA Tourist Attraction.

The first landmark visitors will encounter in Xian is the Ancient City Wall, which stretchesround the old city. The northern side runs parallel to therailway. Xian was originally a walled city, and even today thewall is considered a landmark dividing the city into the inner part and theouter part. The city wall is massive - tall, long and thick. The South Gate and North Gate are the two main entrances to the inner city. The city itself isneatly arranged along the city wall.

The **Shaanxi History Museum**in Xian, regarded as "the pearl of ancient dynasties and house of Chinese treasures", gives aminiature overview of the thousands of years of Chinese history and the splendid ancient cultures of olden times.

VisitTerra Cotta Warriors, Hua Qing Spring Pool.

The Terra Cotta museum is not only atreasure house, but also a main scenic spot of Xian city. Today the eighthwonder of the world has almost become synonym of the Terra-cotta Warriors and Horses in 1987; the Emperor Qins Mausoleum was put on the list of the UNESCO as a world-class cultural heritage site. Now the museum iswidely known as a huge modern site museum and it is going to be one of the bestin the world.

Situated at the northern foot of Mt.Lishan in LintongCounty, 30 kilometers (18.6 miles) from Xian City, **Huaqing Hot Spring** (also called HuaqingPool) is famed for both its dainty spring scenery and the romantic love storyof Emperor Xuanzong (685-762) and his concubine Yang Guifei in the Tang Dynasty (618-907). Its long history and location among the wonderfullandscapes of Xian should entice any visitor to visit and bathe in this hotspring.

Reed Flute Caveis a famous scenicspot, located at the northwest of Guilin City, 5 kilometers awayfrom the centre of the city, mainly offering a magic fairyland of stalactites, stalagmites, stone columns, curtains and flowers in fantastic shapes and colorswhile appreciating landscape and rural scenery.

Elephant Trunk Hill, also called the elephant hill, lies on the conjunction of the Li River and the peach blossom river. It is the badge of Guilin city. The whole hill looksexactly like a huge elephant stretching its trunk drinking water of the LiRiver. It is the masterpiece of karsts landscape, composed of pure limestone deposited on seabed 360 million years ago.
