Beijing served as the capital for 5dynasties over a period of 800 years with each emperor identified as a dragonsent from heaven. Begin your city tour with a visit to the **Summer Palace**, built in classical Chinesestyle in 1750 as a royal recreational resort. Among its famous featuresare the 700-meter-long corridor with its wonderful Painted Gallery, the MarbleBarge, and several magnificently painted pavilions and pagodas. Next stopis the Palace Museum, more commonly known as the **Forbidden City**, untilrecently opened only to the emperors family. This complex, the largestimperial palace ever built in the world, features more than 800 buildings withover 9,000 rooms, resplendent golden- glazed roofs, red lacquered pillars andvermilion walls. See the high-walled "Inner City" with itsgovernment buildings.

Sightseeing continues at the Temple of Heavenwhere the Ming and Qing emperors prayed to heaven for a good harvest.

Beijing

Here is your chance to climb **the Badaling Great Wall** of China! Built 2600 years ago, it is one of the two man-made structures seen by the naked eye of USastronaut Neil Armstrong from outer space. Later visit **the Ming Tombs**, the burial place of thirteen emperors and their families of the Ming Dynasty. Year-long excavations have uncovered many rare treasures such as the gold royal crowns and the silk robes.

Day 4

Beijing/Xian

In the morning fly to Xian. Visit the Wild Goose Pagoda and the ancient city walls

As the symbol of the old-line Xian, **Big Wild Goose Pagoda** (Dayan Pagoda) is a well-preserved ancient building and a holy place for Buddhists. It is located in the southern suburb of Xian City, about 4 kilometers (2.49 miles) from the downtown of the city. Standing in the Da Cien Temple complex, it attracts numerous visitors for its fame in the Buddhist religion, its simple but appealing style of construction, and its new square in front of the temple. It is rated as a National Key Cultural Relic Preserve as well as an AAAA Tourist Attraction.

The first landmark visitors will encounter in Xian is the **Ancient City Wall**, which stretches round the old city. The northern side runs parallel to the railway. Xian was originally a walled city, and even today the wall is considered a landmark dividing the city into the inner part and the outer part. The city wall is massive - tall, long and thick. The South Gate and North Gate are the two main entrances to the inner city. The city itself is neatly arranged along the city wall.

Day 5

Xian

Xian, the cradle of Chinese civilization, was the state capital of 73 emperors spanning 11 dynasties during 1100 years dating from 4,000 B.C. After a visit to the **Huaqing Hot Springs**, also known as the site for the famous Xian Incident, you will visit another wonder of the ancient world - the **Terra-Cotta Warriors**. Concealed under earth, those thousands of life-sized clay warriors, horses and chariots, as one part of the tomb of Emperor Qinshihuang, were accidentally discovered by a farmer while he was digging out a well. You would also see some archaeologists still working on site to uncover the rest part of the vast tomb complex of Emperor Qinshihuang, the first emperor in Chinese history, and also the initiator of the Great Wall.

Take an early morning flight to Guilin, a southwest cityfamous for its splendid natural scenery. Another magnificent view you will not miss is **Elephant TrunkHill**.

In the afternoon fly to Shanghai, the largest metropolis of Chinawith a population of 14 million.

Travel by coach to Suzhou, a city of gardensand waterways. Your first stop today is the well-arranged and elegant **Lingering Garden**, Suzhoulandmarks.

Occupying an area of 23,300 square meters (about 5.8 acres); Lingering Gardenis located outside Changmen Gate in Suzhou, Jiangsu Province. Originallya classical private garden, it is one of the four most famous gardens in China. Possessing typical Qing style, it is well-known for the exquisite beauty of itsmagnificent halls, and the various sizes, shapes, and colors of thebuildings. In 1997, the garden was recorded on the list of the worldheritage by UESCO.

Afterwards attend a demonstration of local silk embroidery needlework at the **NationalEmbroidery Institute**. After lunch, visit the **Hanshan (Cool Hill) Temple** and **TigerHill**.
